- Affirms and functions by the MAAP Code of Ethics for Prevention Specialists, with no prior or pending legal/ethical violations
- Often exceeds expectations and requirements
- Has made observable and measurable contributions to the prevention profession
- Has made observable and measurable contributions to MAAP as an organization
